## WP/SEA MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS Bundling Material with Straps



## **MEMORY JOGGERS** Ensure that the following conditions are met before proceeding. If not met, address on WP/SEA. Communicate the "RIGHT TO STOP WORK AUTHORITY POLICY" and is exercised by all crewmembers and other $\geq$ personnel that believe something or some condition has changed. The job is to be stopped and accessed before proceeding. The WP/SEA may need to be modified or a new WP/SEA maybe required before starting the work task again. Verify that a Crane Lift Plan has been written. ≻ Verify that daily crane inspection has occurred. Verify that straps and slings are in good working order within their certification date. ۶ Verify that a signal person has been identified and that he/she will be in good visual contact with crane operator. $\geq$ ≻ Ensure that only authorized personnel are in the lift area. Inspect certifications for crane operators and riggers and make sure that they are not expired. ۶ $\triangleright$ Ensure that all materials used for task is on hand. **MINIMUM REOUIREMENTS** 1) Verify All conditions identified in the "Memory Joggers" section are met (or are not applicable); if ANY are not met, STOP and add the necessary step to the WP/SEA to ensure the safest method possible. 2) Put one strap around one end of material, placing one eye into the other and tighten. 3) Put another strap around other end of material, placing one eye into the other and tighten. Make sure both straps are choked in the same direction. 4) Attach straps to slings. 5) Signal crane operator to lift load until load becomes a uniform bundle. 6) 7) Riggers tie bundle together using 1/2" rope, using proper knots (i.e. square knots, etc.) Crane operator places bundle in designated area. 8)

9) Return crane, pick up slings, making sure area is clean.
