MEMORY JOGGERS Ensure that the following conditions are met before proceeding. If not met, address on WP/SEA. Communicate the "RIGHT TO STOP WORK AUTHORITY POLICY" and is exercised by all crewmembers and other \triangleright personnel that believe something or some condition has changed. The job is to be stopped and accessed before proceeding. The WP/SEA may need to be modified or a new WP/SEA maybe required before starting the work task again. \triangleright Review the scope of work with all crew members to ensure a clear understanding among the crew. \triangleright Inspect all tools and equipment prior to begin of work Flag off area before begin of work \geq Tie off all tubing and tray to prevent from falling from elevated areas. \geq \triangleright Scan work area for obstructions prior to begin of work. \geq Verify employees are wearing complete PPE. ⊳ Route all extension cords out of walk ways and caution off if needed. Use absorbent pads, rags, and metal containers to contain liquids. \geq **MINIMUM REOUIREMENTS** 1) Verify All conditions identified in the "Memory Joggers" section are met (or are not applicable); if ANY are not met, STOP and add the necessary step to the WP/SEA to ensure the safest method possible. 2) Flag off work area with caution tape. 3) Ensure proper eye and hand protection prior to beginning work When using ladders, secure ladder and do not over extend from center of ladder. 4) When working at heights or near hand rails wear fall protection and ensure rescue plan is in place. 5) 6) Ensure to close valves and bleed off all pressure to lines. Ensure to have absorbent pads, rags and metal container to catch fluid when bleeding lines. 7) 8) Demo tubing that has been bleed down and isolated. Ensure to plug all unplugged fittings. 9) 10) Bend or use bolt cutters to cut tubing into small pieces to place in basket. 11) Remove barricades and dispose of any fluids, rags and trash in proper bins.

12) Return all tools and equipment to proper place.
