Driving Safety

Traffic crashes are the leading cause of all work-related fatalities. It is important to practice safe defensive driving techniques when traveling to work and anytime time you get behind the wheel of a vehicle. Schools are now back in session and extra thought and caution should be given to the reminders provided below.

Safe Driving Reminders:

- Slow down near bus stops and watch out for kids.
- Red flashing lights and an extended stop arm means the school bus has stopped to load or unload children. Do not attempt to PASS a bus with an activated STOP arm.
 - On a two-lane road or a divided roadway with no median, all drivers in both directions must stop.
- Be aware of schools zones.
- Obey all traffic laws, signals and speed limits.
- Avoid talking on cell phones, texting or any other behavior that diverts your attention away from driving.
- Buckle up for safety.
