WP/SEA MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS Offloading/Loading Equipment/Loads from Boat to Truck/Truck to Boat



MEMORY JOGGERS Ensure that the following conditions are met before proceeding. If not met, address on WP/SEA. Communicate the "RIGHT TO STOP WORK AUTHORITY POLICY" and is exercised by all crewmembers and other personnel that believe something or some condition has changed. The job is to be stopped and accessed before proceeding. The WP/SEA may need to be modified or a new WP/SEA maybe required before starting the work task again. Verify that a Crane Lift Plan has been written. Verify that daily crane inspection has occurred. \geq Verify clear access for offloading boat. ۶ Verify that all rigging connections are in compliance with GIS's rigging standards before starting. \triangleright \triangleright Check pad eyes and shackles making sure that they are in good working order. \triangleright Ensure that taglines are attached to load. ۶ Verify that outriggers and pads are in their proper position before attempting the lift. Ensure that only authorized personnel are in the lift area. \geq \geq Verify that truck is in boom reach of the load. Inspect certifications for crane operators and riggers and make sure that they are not expired. \triangleright \triangleright Verify that a signal person has been established on both the vessel and dock that will be in good visibility with the crane operator. \checkmark Verify that there is no oil in drip pan of equipment, if found, clean thoroughly before transferring. Check truck bed for holes, oil and grease. \geq If lift is a bottle rack, ensure a bolt with 2 nuts are fastened tightly ion all doors. \triangleright \geq Verify that a Crane Lift Plan has been written. **MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS** Verify All conditions identified in the "Memory Joggers" section are met (or are not applicable); if ANY are not met, STOP 1) and add the necessary step to the WP/SEA to ensure the safest method possible. Drive crane to location where equipment is to be offloaded. 2) 3) Put out outriggers and pads. Back up truck to crane within crane boom's reach. 4) 5) Hook slings to crane block. Hook slings to unit/equipment to be transferred, unless unit is pre-slung. (If lift is a BOTTLE RACK, ensure a bolt, with 2 6) nuts, are installed tightly in each door before hooking up sling.) Lift load to be put on truck or boat and be aware of personnel's' positions. 7) 8) Repeat Steps 5 through 7 until job is complete. Return crane, pick up slings, making sure area is clean. 9)
