WP/SEA MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS Operating a Forklift



	MEMORY JOGGERS
Ensure that the following conditions are met before proceeding. If not met, address on WP/SEA.	
\succ	Communicate the "RIGHT TO STOP WORK AUTHORITY POLICY" and is exercised by all crewmembers and other
	personnel that believe something or some condition has changed. The job is to be stopped and accessed before proceeding.
	The WP/SEA may need to be modified or a new WP/SEA maybe required before starting the work task again.
\succ	Ensure there are no power lines in the vicinity of the lift, if so, get a spotter to help guide the forklift safely.
\triangleright	Ensure that a GIS Forklift Checklist has been completed at the beginning of the shift.
\triangleright	Seatbelts should be in good working order, not rusted or frayed.
\triangleright	Check for extinguisher making sure it is not out of date and easy to get to.
\succ	Horn must be in good working order, easy for anyone to hear in its proximity.
\succ	Ensure back-up beeper is working.
\triangleright	Make sure there are no leaks such as oil and hydraulic fluid.
\triangleright	Ensure level terrain in travel area before operating forklift.
MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS	
1)	Verify All conditions identified in the "Memory Joggers" section are met (or are not applicable); if <u>ANY</u> are not met, <u>STOP</u>
	and add the necessary step to the WP/SEA to ensure the safest method possible.
2)	Board the forklift using 3 point contact.
3)	Sit and adjust seat and mirrors.
4)	Fasten seatbelt and tighten.
5)	Start engine and lift forks approximately 6 inches or higher, depending on terrain.
6)	Look around for pedestrians and other vehicles.
7)	When clear, put forklift in gear and proceed to load.
8)	When at load, establish center of gravity.
9)	Slide forks all the way under the load until it reaches the vertical frame.
	Lift load to desired height and tilt back slightly.
	Look around for pedestrians and other vehicles.
	When clear, put forklift in gear and proceed to destination of load.
	Lower load at destination, look for anything behind unit, and back out from under load.
	Repeat steps 7 through 13 until task is complete.
	When all lifts are complete, return forklift to its storage area.
	Lower forks to ground and tilt forward, to avoid trip hazards.
17)	Turn off engine, remove seatbelt and exit forklift using 3 point contact.
