Winter Weather Safety

Over the next 72-hours, a mass of arctic air is expected to bring historic snowfall, ice, and wintry mixes to a substantial part of the southern United States. As large portions of the populations begin to prepare for this historic event, G.I.S. would like to remind all our team members to keep safety at the forefront, especially when driving. One of the most important tips to staying safe is to **remain off the roadways unless you absolutely must travel**.



Some other tips to remain safe while traveling during this event include:

- “Ice & Snow Take it Slow” – Keep it slow and don’t use cruise control.
- Clean off your vehicle before driving, flying snow from vehicles can cause incidents.
- Leave extra distances between vehicles. Accelerate and decelerate slowly.
- Ensure your vehicle is properly maintained, such as windshield wipers in good condition, working hazard lights, and a full tank of fuel.
- Always check road conditions before you travel and have a journey management plan.
