Dropped Object

WHAT HAPPENED:

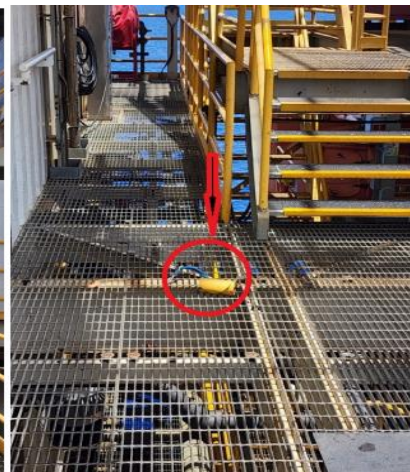
Recently, a blaster/painter working on an elevation – approximately 10' to 12' above grade, attempted to put a new roll of sanding discs on his tool lanyard and dropped it towards the deck. No personnel were injured because of this, nor was anyone in the line of fire at the time of the incident. Barricades which were erected around the work area prevented anyone from walking into line of fire.

WHY DID THIS HAPPEN?

The employee was performing a routine task without proper awareness and made the poor decision to add materials to his lanyard while still at elevation, as opposed to doing the proper thing and going down to grade to perform the task.

CORRECTIVE ACTIONS:

- A Safety Stand Down was conducted by the Supervisor on-site immediately following the incident as a means of reviewing all factors, findings, and mitigations.
- An additional Safety Stand Down was conducted to review GIS Policy LLCP-064-Dropped-Object-01 and LLCF-018-Dropped-Object-Checklist.
