Hard Hat Lanyard

A recent safety bulletin was sent out from BSEE (Bureau of Safety and Environmental Enforcement) based on their observations of personnel in the industry utilizing tool lanyards in the place of hard hat lanyards.

Tool lanyard

A tool lanyard attached to a worker with a carabiner latch can pose a serious risk of injury when used on or near rotating or moving equipment. The tool lanyard may get wrapped or caught into the moving equipment causing the employee to make contact with the rotating or moving equipment increasing the risk of a serious injury to employees. Hard hat lanyards are designed to break away with 2 lbs. of force which will lessen the risk of that type of incident from occurring.

- Always use the proper tool for the job: Ensure *hard hat lanyards are only being used for hard hats*, and *tool lanyards are only being used for tools*.
- Always use *Stop Work Authority* if you observe someone not using the proper tool or equipment for the task.
