

## WP/SEA MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS Slate Removal



## **MEMORY JOGGERS**

## Ensure that the following conditions are met before proceeding. If not met, address on WP/SEA.

- Communicate the "RIGHT TO STOP WORK AUTHORITY POLICY" and is exercised by all crewmembers and other personnel that believe something or some condition has changed. The job is to be stopped and accessed before proceeding. The WP/SEA may need to be modified or a new WP/SEA maybe required before starting the work task again.
- Make sure slate is generously wet using soapy water, spray with potato pump.
- Ensure that storage container(s) are on site, provided by Customer.
- > Danger Tape entire worksite as to avoid non-workers from entering area.
- Create Staging Area for removed slate.
- Ensure all workers are wearing Tyvex suits, safety glasses, gloves, dust masks, steel toe boots and hard hats!!
- Make sure Tyvex suit sleeves are taped tight at ends of arms and legs.

## MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

- 1) Verify **All** conditions identified in the "Memory Joggers" section are met (or are not applicable); if **ANY** are not met, **STOP** and add the necessary step to the WP/SEA to ensure the safest method possible.
- 2) Generously wet down small area of slate that is to be removed, using soapy water from a potato pump.
- 3) Carefully remove one (1) piece of slate at a time and gently place in storage container provided by Customer to avoid cracking or breaking material.
- 4) Remove remaining pieces of slate, one (1) piece at a time, in area that is saturated with soapy water and place in storage container.
- 5) Continue Steps 2 through 4 until removal is complete.
- 6) Clean area making sure all removed slate has been placed in storage container(s).
- 7) Return tools and equipment to their proper storage area.
- 8) Remove Tyvex suits and gloves and place in storage container(s).
- 9) Remove Danger Tape and exit work area.
