WP/SEA MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS Working in Distribution Panel



MEMORY JOGGERS

Ensure that the following conditions are met before proceeding. If not met, address on WP/SEA.

- Communicate the "RIGHT TO STOP WORK AUTHORITY POLICY" and is exercised by all crewmembers and other personnel that believe something or some condition has changed. The job is to be stopped and accessed before proceeding. The WP/SEA may need to be modified or a new WP/SEA maybe required before starting the work task again.
- > Electrical Shocks.
- > Incidental Shutdown of other devices.
- > Burns or injury due to arc flash.
- Damage to equipment.
- > Injury due to insects

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

- 1) Verify **All** conditions identified in the "Memory Joggers" section are met (or are not applicable); if **ANY** are not met, **STOP** and add the necessary step to the WP/SEA to ensure the safest method possible.
- 2) Flag off area with danger tape and install tags with company name, supervisor contact number, and list all hazards
- 3) Ensure fire extinguisher is on site
- 4) Only qualified personnel are to work in energized panels with proper PPE on, use LOTO where needed.
- 5) All terminations should be checked to verify voltage is present or non voltage
- 6) Visit Minimum Requirement for pulling Electric Cable
- 7) Visit Minimum Requirement for Installing Transformer
- 8) Keep work area clean to prevent slipping and falling into energized panel.
- 9) Make sure hot work permit is filled out on site before starting work.
- 10) Remove all barriers, trash and debris
- 11) Return tools to proper bins
